SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT - JUST WATCH THE BIRDS!

This morning, I glanced out the window as I opened the blinds in my office. The colorful flowers my husband planted around our yard drew my eyes in every direction. "Good choices!" I said aloud. Just before I turned to my desk, a bush along the back fence moved. Then, a clump of its branches shook wildly! It looked as though someone was shaking that bush from behind. Before I could investigate, three birds hopped to the edges of those branches. They were jumping and poking at each other with all their might. The teacher in me couldn't help getting involved. "What are you three fighting about?" Suddenly, it was as though that mischievous trio heard me. They stopped pecking at each other and settled in a row on that branch. Then, each one turned in my direction...

I admit that I instinctively looked upward to say, "Dear God, you didn't have to send that trio to remind me that I'm writing for Trinity Sunday! I'm already fretting about where to go with..." Then, it hit me! God was well aware of my mental state. In a lovingly playful way, God used those feathered imps to help me out. The Triune God I know -Father, Son and Spirit- doesn't carry



on like those fighting birds. However, our intermingled, Three-in-One and One-Who-is-Three God does tune in to us every minute of every day. Our God is always looking to love, to care, to encourage, and to give direction. It's up to us to pay attention whether God comes in delinquent birds on rustling branches or in the moments of peaceful quiet that come our way.

When I sat to write, I couldn't help smiling. Yes, I'm still smiling! Those birds are inspiring my thoughts! You see, every day, I watch them or their counterparts in our yard as they flit about. Sometimes, these feathered friends nestle near the bird feeder where either my husband or other birds have dropped seeds. Most often, each one settles over its own cache to enjoy a meal. I always marvel when this occurs. "We humans could learn a lot from you," I tell them. Sometimes, a squirrel and a rabbit join the feasting crowd. It warms my heart to see them sharing our backyard's bounty together.

At other times, however, the opposite is true. A bully bird swoops down and scares another bird away from its meal. Sometimes, a squirrel gets aggressive because its own portion of seed isn't quite large enough that day. Sometimes, even a usually mild-mannered

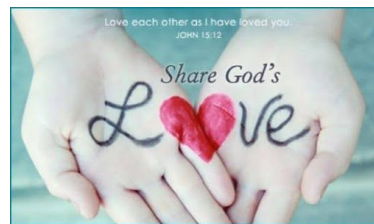
rabbit will nudge a smaller animal away. It's during these times that I long for a peacemaker -or a stronger animal- to frighten the rest into cooperative submission. Ugh! I don't like the sound of that! Neither does God! Who wants a bunch of followers who simply agree to cooperative submission?

You know, I wasn't sure of what God had in mind when I saw those birds this morning. Now I get it! It was no accident when Jesus referenced God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Jesus introduced us to himself, to God the Father, and to God the Holy Spirit because he wanted to reveal the amazing depth of God's love for us. Think about it! To share Divine Love with us, God our Father created the universe and each of us. Since we humans sometimes wander from the path before us, God our Brother Jesus came to show us how to navigate our lives a bit more efficiently -and far more lovingly. This was tough because Jesus took on our humanity in the process. Jesus lived and loved, ached and worried as only we humans can. Jesus did this all to show us the way.

Now we know how this went for Jesus. Despite his best efforts, some of us missed the point. Some went so far as to get the point and then reject it. Some were threatened enough by Jesus loving ways to go beyond rejection to absolute hatred. These are the ones who saw to Jesus' death. Fortunately, this isn't the end of the story. After hours on the cross, Jesus breathed his last. While some tended to his burial, Jesus reunited with Father and Spirit. I can only imagine the love in that reunion! Then, three days later, Jesus returned to say he'd risen as he promised. Then, The Spirit -God's Holy Spirit- came to fill us all!

Though we can no longer see Jesus with our eyes, God's Spirit remains within each of us. Never again will we be separated from God's love for us, Jesus' example, and God's Spirit. Like the birds who make their homes in our backyard, God makes a home within you and me. It occurs to me that the best way to celebrate Trinity Sunday- God

Sunday! - is to share God's love at every opportunity! Let's celebrate! Let's do it!

GOSPEL MEDITATION



I was 16 years old on a youth group retreat in the mountains. One night, I opened my heart to the message being proclaimed: that God so loved the world that He sent His Son for us. Later, I lay under the pine trees and looked up at the countless stars. They seemed different. No longer cold, distant balls of chemical reactions, they appeared as an expression of God's love, as if He were giving those stars directly to me. The truth of God sending His Son changed how I saw the whole universe.

That is what today's Gospel reveals: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son." (John 3:16) The universe is not just a whirl of impersonal forces or empty space. At its heart is a gift: the Father eternally giving the Son, not to condemn, but to bring life.

This is not abstract doctrine but deeply personal. God gives His Son for you and me. Each human life is precious enough to be caught up in that eternal gift.

It is in the Mass where we encounter this most directly. In the Word proclaimed, in the assembly gathered, in the priest, and above all in the Eucharist, the Father once again gives His Son. What looks like bread and wine is the drama of the Trinity, laboring to love us here and now.

The Trinity is not a puzzle to solve but the blazing Truth at the center of everything: the Father gives the Son for you and me. Lord, help us to see this more clearly.



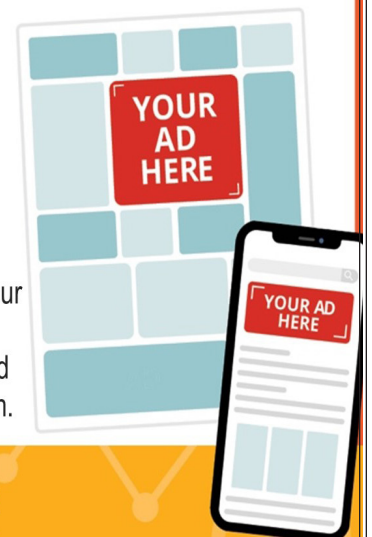

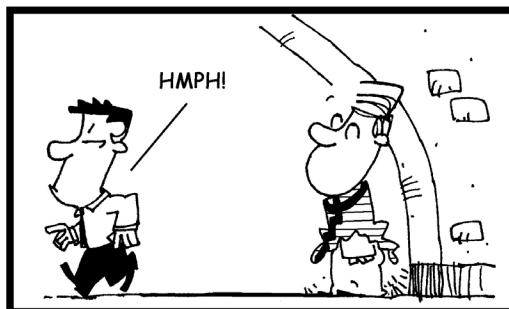
