## SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT- MAKE ROOM FOR EVERYONE!

A few weeks ago, my husband and I attended a retirement party for a friend. Because the guest of honor had spent her career teaching, Mike and I understand her joy, her gratitude, and her relief. We also understand that the life she shared with her students will always be a part of her. When we drove home from that party, we went through North Chicago where Mike had served as a principal and I as a teacher (in different schools, of course!). Raindrops danced on the windshield, Mike sang along with the radio, and I lost myself in memories of children who'd spent a school year with me.

Because we'd had a really nice time at that party, I was taken aback by the surge of emotion I experienced as we drove along. Suddenly, the best and the most trying events of my teaching career filled me up. Those good times included breakthroughs for challenged students, special projects and programs, field trips and, of course, class parties. Days when everyone cooperated were also reason to celebrate. Misbehavior and its consequences were no fun for anyone. Even innocent onlookers shuddered when one of their own was in trouble. Fortunately, my third graders didn't often challenge my methods in this regard.

Still, I'll never forget the year three of my third graders misbehaved just enough to compel me to exclude them from our class Christmas Party. Despite my warnings, they'd misbehaved once too often. When I told the boys that they'd spend that precious afternoon in the principal's office, they were crestfallen. The truth is that they were so upset that they melted into the woodwork by party day. I hardly knew they were in class because they'd joined in their classmates' good behavior so completely. When this trio prepared to leave the room on party day, I asked if they understood. After they mumbled something about "being bad and learning to be good", I invited them to stay. I acknowledged that they'd really behaved well that week and that our party wouldn't be the same if they weren't with us. I also didn't want them to miss the treats and little gifts I'd prepared for them. You see, I really loved those kids. Those boys would never have forgotten third grade if that was the year they'd missed their Christmas Party. Perhaps they haven't forgotten third grade because it was the year that their teacher treated them with unexpected mercy...

I know. We celebrated Christmas five months ago and Easter has come and gone. Why, then, am I writing about a children's Christmas Party from

decades ago on the day we celebrate Jesus' body and blood? Perhaps I'm compelled to do so by the same Spirit who inspired Matthew, Mark, Luke and John to write about the

miracle of the loaves and fishes. This event is one of a select few which appear in all four gospels, and it's no wonder. This story highlights Jesus' favorite activity -sharing a meal with his friends. Jesus performed his first public miracle at a wedding dinner. He ate with tax collectors and sinners. Jesus welcomed a woman of questionable reputation when she interrupted a meal to bathe his feet with her tears. Jesus broke bread with whoever invited him in. Jesus also often invited himself in. Jesus called Zacchaeus down from a tree and asked to be taken home for supper. Jesus cured Peter's mother-in-law who quickly got up to make dinner for Jesus and his friends. Today's gospel (Luke 9:11b-17) describes Jesus' best-attended meal...

Jesus had spent the day preaching to a crowd of over five thousand. The disciples told Jesus to disperse the people so they could find food for themselves. Jesus responded by asking the disciples to feed them. They eventually brought a boy who had a few fish and some bread to Jesus. Jesus blessed it and then asked his friends to distribute it. Jesus didn't tell them to feed his neighbors from Nazareth first or to feed their fellow Jews before the Gentiles. Jesus didn't tell them to feed the men and women and children in any particular order. Jesus simply asked that the disciples give them all some food. God loved the motley crowd who'd spent hours listening that day and Jesus was determined to make that love known to them through this meal. One day, Jesus would do the same at his last supper.

Jesus' efforts in this regard inspired me to include my three troublesome students in our class party that day. To have done otherwise would have deprived them of a small taste of God's all-inclusive love. Sending them to the principal's office would have deprived me of seeing those boys at their grateful bests. On this day when we celebrate the body Jesus used to care for us and the blood Jesus poured out for us, we're all invited to do as Jesus did -to sit at table, sometimes figuratively and sometimes literally, with everyone we meet along the way. We share Jesus best when we love one another as he did.

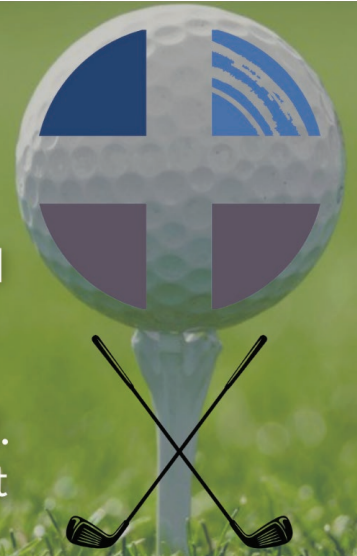

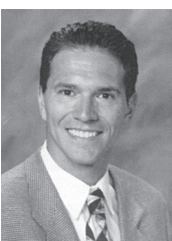

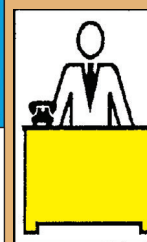
